2. Application Procedure

2.1. M.Tech. (Full Time, Stipendiary)

As decided in NIT Council, M.Tech. admission for all National Institute of Technologies will be conducted by centralized admission procedure. The Centralized Counselling for M. Tech. Admissions 2012 (CCMT 2012) for candidates possessing GATE score (2011 or 2012), to all the National Institutes of Technology (NITs) will be conducted by inviting online application through website http://ccmt2012.mnit.ac.in. Through a single application a candidate can apply for as many Institute/Programme as he/she wishes. A Applicant could check her/his eligibility for various programs on the website. 2.2. M.Tech. (Part Time and sponsored)

Eligible candidates are required to download the application form from the Institute website ww.mnnit.ac.in. Dully filled-in and signed application form along with a demand draft of ₹1000/- (₹500/- for SC/ST) in favour of **Director**, **MNNIT** payable at **Allahabad** must reach toe **The Admission Cell**, **Office of the Dean** (**Academic**), **Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad**, **Allahabad** – **211004** latest by May 25, 2012 up to 5.30 PM.

Note: A candidate willing to apply for more than one programme in different department has to apply separately with a demand draft of ₹1000/- (₹500/- for SC/ST) for each programme.

3. Eligibility for Admission

3.1 Eligibility requirement for M.Tech. (Full-time Stipendiary)

As per CCMT-2012. Please refer to http://ccmt2012.mnit.ac.in/

The admission to M.Tech. programme will be based on the Percentile/Score secured by the candidate at the Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE). (Eligibility requirement for various programmes and number of seats are given subsequently.)

3.2 Eligibility requirement in M.Tech. (Part Time)

These Part-time programmes are run under the School of Non-formal and Continuing Education (SNFCE). These programmes are of 03 years duration out of which 02 years are scheduled for completion of course work and one year for the Thesis/Dissertation/Projects. These courses are offered to working professionals who are working in and around Allahabad City, up to a maximum limit of 50 KM from Allahabad. Candidates with minimum 02 years of working experience at the time of registration are eligible for admission.

- (i) The eligibility conditions given below are the absolute minimum. Departments may prescribe any other requirements over and above the absolute minimum, subject to the approval of the SPGC.
- (ii) The "specified minimum" marks/CPI (Cumulative Performance Index), referred to in subsequent sections, implies a minimum of 60% aggregate marks or equivalent CPI for M.Tech. For SC/ST candidates eligibility in specified minimum marks is relaxed to 55% or equivalent.
- (iii) Reservation: For M.Tech. programmes presently 27% seats are reserved for OBC candidates (including 4.5% for OBC citizens of minority community), 15% seats are reserved for the Scheduled Castes candidates and 7.5% seats are reserved for the Scheduled Tribes candidates. For persons with physical disability (PD) 3% seats are reserved horizontally as prescribed by Government of India.
- (iv) The applicant must have a Bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology or a Master's degree in appropriate discipline with marks/CPI not below the specified minimum.

3.3 Eligibility requirement in M.Tech. (Sponsored) Candidates

The institute may also admit sponsored candidates to full time M.Tech. Programmes. Following guidelines will be followed for admission to this category:

- (i) The candidates who have Bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology/Pharmacy/Architecture/Planning or equivalent from AICTE approved institutions with at least 60% Marks or equivalent CPI (55% or equivalent for SC/ST candidates) will be eligible for admission. Preference will be given to those candidates who are GATE qualified. Sponsored candidates will not be eligible to receive scholarship, even if they are admitted based on GATE Score.
- (ii) The candidates must have a minimum of two Years of Full-Time work experience as on the date of registration in a registered firm/company/industry/educational and research institution/any government department or government autonomous organizations in the relevant field in which admission is being sought. A proof in this respect must be submitted along with the application form.
- (iii) A letter from the employer must be furnished at the time of test / interview stating that the candidate is being sponsored to get admission. The employer should also indicate that the candidates will not be withdrawn midway till the completion of the course. In case a candidate fails to produce the sponsorship letter, he/she shall not be interviewed.

(b) Mess charges

7.2. M.Tech. (Sponsored / Part-time)

Name of shortlisted candidates will be displayed on the Institute website on 05.6.2012 with the details of written examination / interview to be conducted by Admission Cell/Examination Cell in association with respective departments. Tentative schedule of the written examination / interview for different departments are given in section 8.

Important Notes:

- (i) Separate application forms must be filled for courses offered by different departments along with the prescribed fee. However, separate fee is not to be paid for separate courses offered by the same department.
- (ii) No separate letter will be sent by the institute for attending the test/interview/Counseling.
- (iii) Candidates are advised to visit the Institute website **www.mnnit.ac.in** for regular update.
- (iv) The name of the short listed candidates shall also be displayed on the Notice Board of the Departments. The written examination and/or counseling will commence from 10.00 A.M.
- (v) No candidate shall be considered for written examination / interview without the result of the qualifying examination. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally, only if he/she submits a certificate on the dated of written examination / interview from the Principal/Registrar of his/her College/Institute stating that the candidate has completed all the requirements for obtaining the qualifying degree on the date of the issue of the certificate. However, mark sheet of qualifying examination with requisite marks or equivalent CGPA must be submitted to the office of Dean (Academic) on or before the first week of September 2012, failing which will lead to cancellation of admission.

Note: No candidate shall be considered for counseling without the result of the qualifying examination. However as a special case, if the results are not available, they should produce proof that they have completed all the requirement of qualifying examination from the Director / Principal of the Institute. In such cases Final mark sheet should be submitted on the day of counseling/registration, otherwise admission will be automatically cancelled.

 - d. Certificate of sponsorship (if applicable).
 - e. No. Objection certificate from employer (if applicable).
 - f. OBC/SC/ST/PH certificate, if applicable.
 - g. Certificate of OBMC (for a sub-quota of 4.5% for minorities within the 27% reservation for OBCs)

- (ii) The candidates are required to bring following documents at the time of registration i.e. on 14.7.2012:
 - a. Passport size Photographs (5 Nos.).
 - b. One set of attested copies of all the above documents listed in section 12 (i) above.
 - c. Admission letter

- Note: 1. The institute reserves the right to refuse admission to any candidate without assigning any reason. All disputes are subject to Allahabad High Court only.
 - 2. The number of seats may vary without prior notice.

10. Eligibility requirements for scholarship

All GATE qualified candidates admitted to a full-time programme in M.Tech. (except under non-stipendiary category) are eligible for scholarship subject to the laid down norms of the MHRD, Govt. of India.

In case a candidate leaves the programme in-between, he/she will have to refund the entire money drawn by him/her as scholarship. Beside this he/she will have to clear all the dues pending against him/her.
